

## MAN plant in Munich

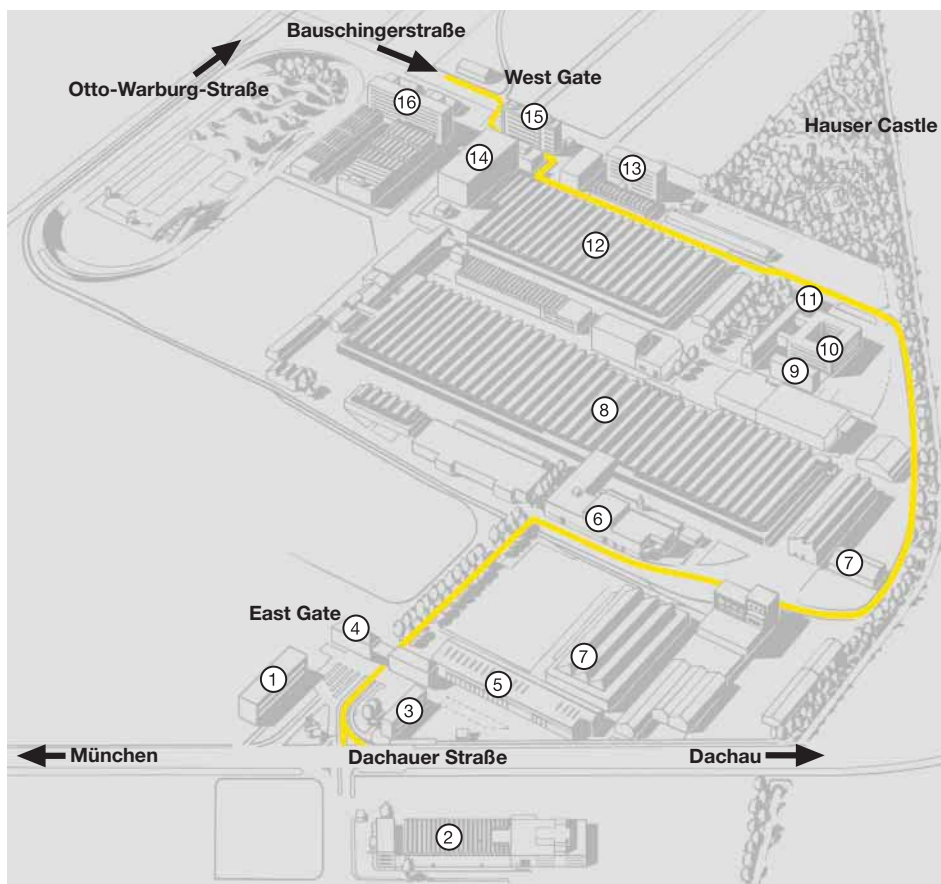
The Munich plant is the head office of MAN Nutzfahrzeuge AG and the largest production facility in the MAN Group.

## We look forward to your visit

This "Guide to the Munich plant" gives you an overview of the main roads and junctions in the Greater Munich area. We hope that it will help you to find your way to MAN - as directly as possible.

We wish you a good trip and a pleasant visit to MAN.



### Nürnberg (A9) or Deggendorf (A92) motorways:

Motorway junction - München-Neufahrn, towards Stuttgart on A92 to motorway intersection München-Feldmoching. Continue on A99 towards Stuttgart until the München-Ludwigsfeld exit. Continue on B304 towards Dachau to the main security office at the East Gate. You reach the main security office at the West Gate via Otto-Warburg Straße and Bauschingerstraße.

### Stuttgart motorway (A8):

Towards München. Drive past the Dachau exit. Continue on A99 towards Salzburg until the München-Ludwigsfeld exit. Continue as described for the Nürnberg motorway.

### Garmisch (A95) and Lindau (A96) motorways:

Continue until the motorway ends on the ring road (Mittlerer Ring/Landshuter Allee). Turn towards Dachau and continue on B304 (Dachauer Straße) until plant.

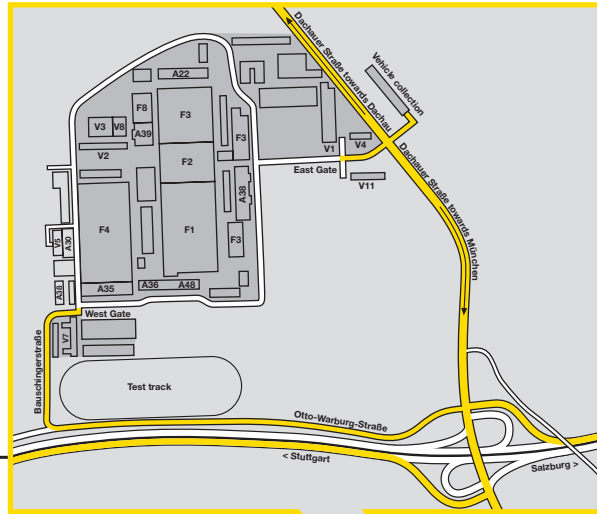
### Salzburg motorway (A8):

Motorway junction - München-Brunnthal, towards Nürnberg on A99 until motorway junction - München-Nord. Continue towards Stuttgart via the motorway intersection - München-Feldmoching on A99 until München-Ludwigsfeld exit. Continue as described for the Nürnberg motorway.

### Passau motorway (A94):

Motorway junction - München-Ost, towards Nürnberg on A99. Continue towards Stuttgart via the motorway junction München-Nord and motorway intersection München-Feldmoching until the München-Ludwigsfeld exit. Continue as described for Nürnberg motorway.

Cars and taxis can drive into the plant, right to the department that you are visiting. The main security office will give you a visitor's slip and a permit to drive in.



### From Munich's Franz-Josef-Strauß Airport:

Take a taxi to MAN (takes about 30-40 minutes) or take the airport bus or suburban train line number 8 to the main station or suburban train line number 1 to Moosach. Continue with suburban line train, tram or bus (see journey by rail).



### From Munich's main station:

Take a taxi (takes about 30 minutes) or the suburban train line number 2 to Karlsfeld station. You reach the main security office at the West Gate on foot in about 5 minutes. From Munich's main station you can also take the tram number 15/20 or the suburban train line 1 to the Moosach suburban line station and change there to the bus number 710 to Dachau which stops right in front of the plant and the main security office at the East Gate.
